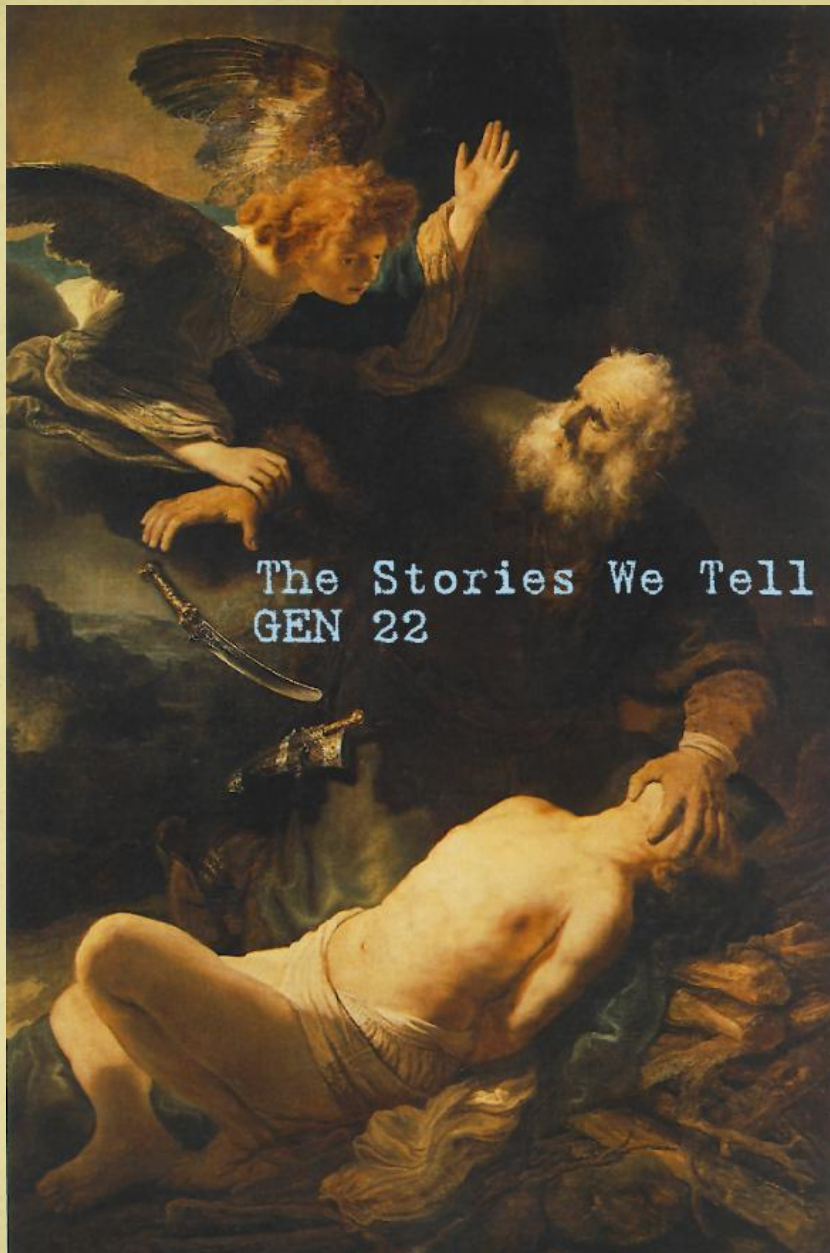


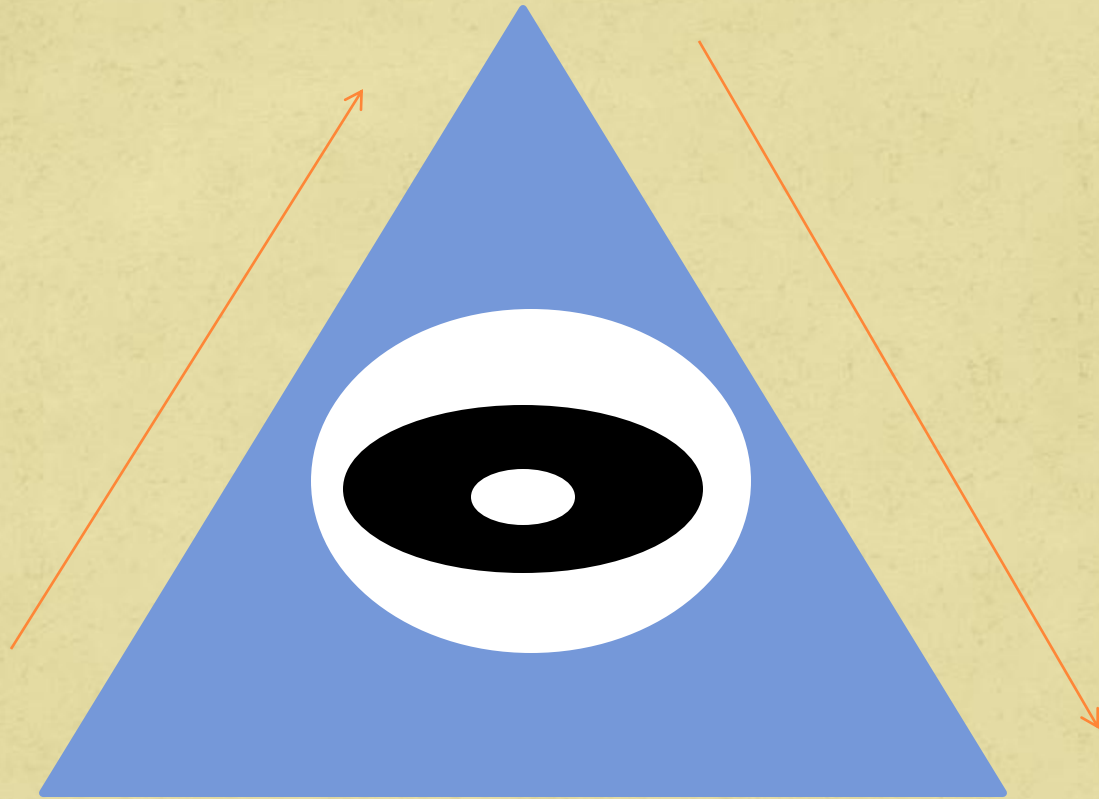


1 Cor 15:1-4 / Korint'anom 15:1-4

¹Now, brothers, I want to remind you of the gospel I preached to you, which you received and on which you have taken your stand. ²By this gospel you are saved, if you hold firmly to the word I preached to you. Otherwise, you have believed in vain. ³For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance^[a]: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, ⁴that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures,

¹ Rád by som vám, bratia, pripomenul, že aj dnes hlásam to isté radostné posolstvo, čo na začiatku, ako ste ho aj vy prijali a na ňom založili svoju vieru. ² V ňom je vaša záchrana, kým sa ho pevne držíte v tej podobe, ako som vám ho odovzdal. 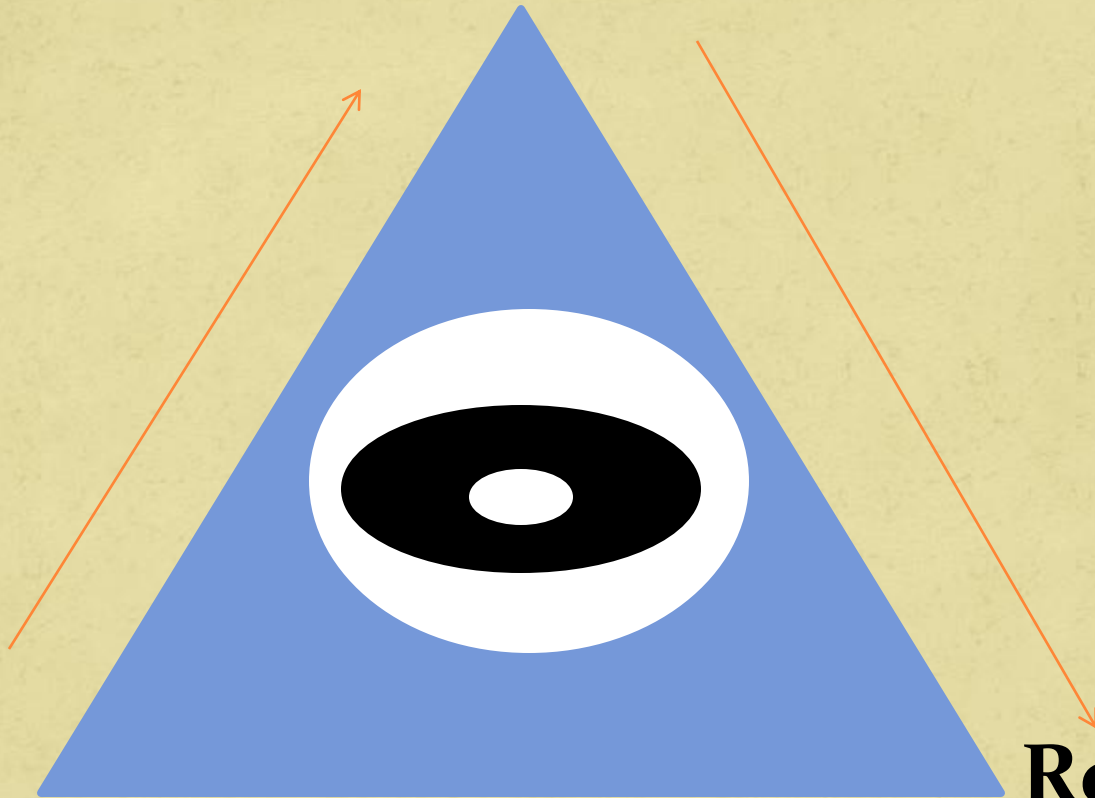

Gen 22:1-8 /

¹ Some time later God tested Abraham. He said to him, "Abraham!"

"Here I am," he replied. ² Then God said, "Take your son, your only son, Isaac, whom you love, and go to the region of Moriah. Sacrifice him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains I will tell you about."

³ Early the next morning Abraham got up and saddled his donkey. He took with him two of his servants and his son Isaac. When he had cut enough wood for the burnt offering, he set out for the place God had told him about. ⁴ On the third day Abraham looked up and saw the place in the distance. ⁵ He said to his servants, "Stay here with the donkey while I and the boy go over there. We will worship and then we will come back to you."

⁶ Abraham took the wood for the burnt offering and placed it on his son Isaac, and he himself carried the fire and the knife. As the two of them went on together, ⁷ Isaac spoke up and said to his father Abraham, "Father?"

"Yes, my son?" Abraham replied.

"The fire and wood are here," Isaac said, "but where is the lamb for the burnt offering?"

⁸ Abraham answered, "God himself will provide the lamb for the burnt offering, my son." And the two of them went on together.

Heb 11:17-19 / Hebrejom 11:17-19

¹⁷By faith Abraham, when God tested him, offered Isaac as a sacrifice. He who had received the promises was about to sacrifice his one and only son, ¹⁸even though God had said to him, "It is through Isaac that your offspring will be reckoned." ¹⁹Abraham reasoned that God could raise the dead, and figuratively speaking, he did receive Isaac back from death.

¹⁷ Abrahám neochvejne veril Bohu, aj keď Boh podrobil jeho vieru veľkej skúške. Bol ochotný obetovať svojho jediného syna, hoci dostal zaslúbenie,

¹⁸ že z Izáka bude pochádzať jeho potomstvo.

¹⁹ Rátal s tým, že Boh má moc vzkriesiť aj mŕtvych. Preto dostal Izáka späť ako predobraz budúceho vzkriesenia.

Gen 22:9-19 / 1 Mojžišova 22:9-19

9 Keď však došli na miesto, o ktorom mu povedal Hospodin, Abrahám tam postavil oltár, naukladal drevo, zviazal syna Izáka a položil ho na oltár navrch dreva. 10 Keď Abrahám vystrel ruku a vzal nôž, aby zarezal syna, 11 zavolať na neho z neba anjel Hospodinov: Abrahám, Abrahám! A ten odpovedal: Tu som. 12 Tu mu on riekol: Nevystieraj ruku na chlapca a neubližuj mu, lebo teraz som spoznal, že sa bojíš Boha, a neodoprel si mi ani svojho syna, svojho jediného syna. 13 Vtedy Abrahám pozdvihol oči a zbadal, že v húšti je baran zachytený za rohy. Abrahám šiel, vzal barana a namiesto svojho syna ho obetoval ako spaľovanú obeť. 14 Vtedy Abrahám pomenoval to miesto: Hospodin si vyhliadne, ako sa podnes hovorí: Na vrchu si Hospodin vyhliadne.

15 Potom anjel Hospodinov zavolať z neba na Abraháma druhý raz 16 a riekol: Prisahám na seba - znie výrok Hospodinov: Pretože si to urobil a neodoprel si mi svojho jediného syna, 17 veľmi ťa požehnám, a tak veľmi rozmnožím tvoje potomstvo, že ho bude ako hviezd na nebi a ako piesku na brehu morskem, tvoje potomstvo zaujme mestá svojich nepriateľov. 18 A v tvojom potomstve požehnané budú všetky národy zeme, pretože si poslúchol môj hlas. 19 Nato sa Abrahám vrátil ku svojim sluhom. Potom vstali a spolu šli do Beér-Šeby; a Abrahám býval v Beér-Šebe.

John 19:16-18 / Jána 19:16-18

¹⁶Finally Pilate handed him over to them to be crucified. So the soldiers took charge of Jesus. ¹⁷Carrying his own cross, he went out to the place of the Skull (which in Aramaic is called Golgotha). ¹⁸Here they crucified him, and with him two others—one on each side and Jesus in the middle.

¹⁶ Tu sa Pilát vzdal a vydal rozkaz, aby Ježiša ukrižovali.

¹⁷ Tak sa ho konečne zmocnili a viedli von z mesta na kopec zvaný Lebka, po hebrejsky Golgota. Kríž musel niesť na vlastných pleciach. ¹⁸ Tam ho naň pribili a ukrižovali. Po oboch stranách vztýčili kríže dvoch zločincov.

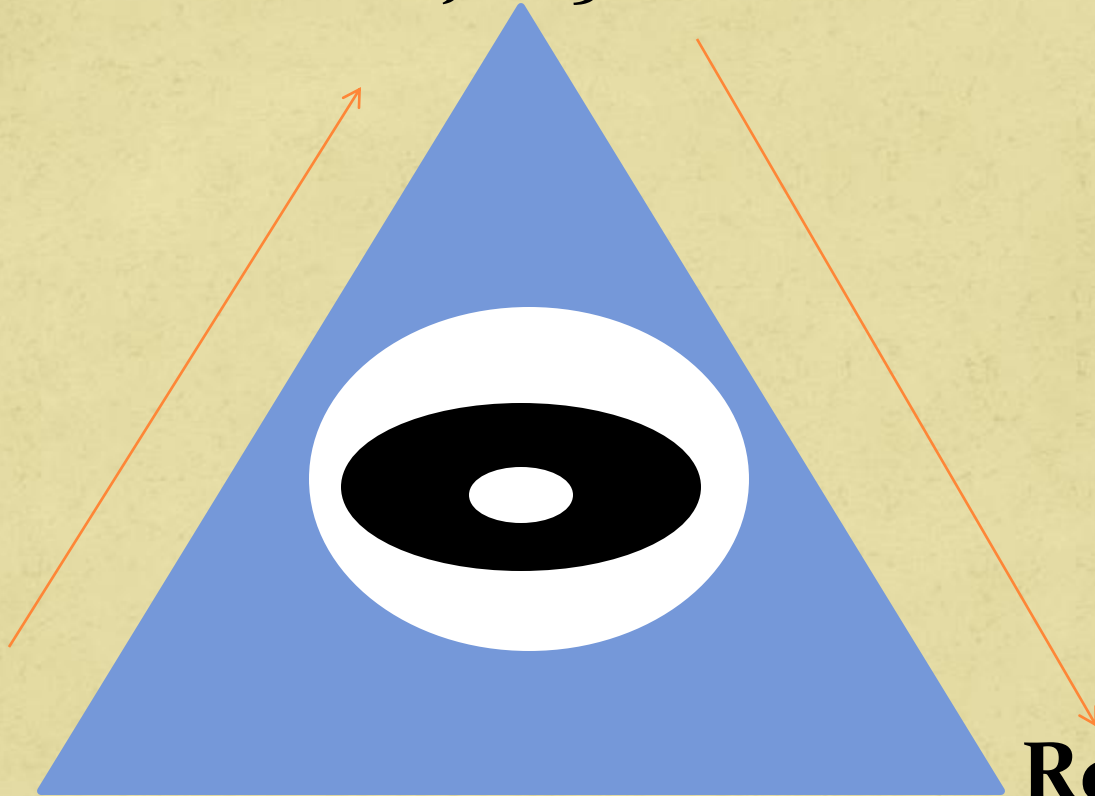

Gal 3:6-9 / List Galat'anom 3:6-9

⁶Consider Abraham: "He believed God, and it was credited to him as righteousness."^[a] ⁷Understand, then, that those who believe are children of Abraham. ⁸The Scripture foresaw that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, and announced the gospel in advance to Abraham: "All nations will be blessed through you."⁹ So those who have faith are blessed along with Abraham, the man of faith.

⁶ Spomeňte si, čo vraví Písmo o Abrahámovi: Abrahám uveril Bohu, a Boh ho preto uznal za spravodlivého." ⁷ To predsa znamená, že Božím ľuďom, pravými synmi Abraháma, sú tí, čo veria a dôverujú Bohu ako Abrahám. ⁸ Písmo už dávno poukazovalo na to, že Boh spasí skrze vieru aj pohanov.
